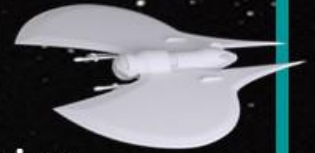
- ★ Thanks to the TKES training, I was able to get 3's and 4's on my evaluations. It helped me know what I needed to know.
