VOUCHER BILL DEFEATED ON LAST DAY OF SESSION:

16 REPUBLICANS JOIN ALL BUT ONE DEMOCRAT TO KILL THE BILL

This year's private school voucher bill came to a spectacular and abrupt end late this evening as House members rejected SB 233, 85-89. The bill proposed to provide a new \$6,500 private school tuition subsidy. Under the proposal, for every dollar the poorest 25% of public schools received in state funding, the bill took twice that to pay for private school.

Sixteen Republicans withstood tremendous political pressure from the Speaker Pro-Tempore of the House, Rep. Jan Jones, R-North Fulton, and Gov. Brian Kemp, who endorsed the bill and fought for its passage. One Democrat, Rep. Mesha Mainor, D-Atlanta, who represents downtown Atlanta, south to Booker T. Washington High School, and down to near Cascade Elementary, was the only member of her party to vote for the bill.

A comprehensive review of the session is forthcoming.
